On an average, around 20 institutions including Cotton University, Tezpur University, and B. Barooah college participate in the competition in 2022.

6. Problems encountered and resources required:

Although many institutions are invited to the competition, the number of participating institutions is not satisfactory. In the hectic schedule of semester classes, there is a time constraint to organise such event.
